
Who we are and what we do

- The Kent based fostering agency ISP (Integrated Services Provision) founded a Children's Foundation in 2003. By 2015 its success had grown and it was relaunched as a charity on a nationwide basis, entitled The Spark Foundation.
- The Spark Foundation runs a small grants programme for young people up to the age of 26 who either are or who have been in care in England and Wales.
- The aim of the grants is to help with education or training, encourage hobbies, skills and social interaction, and provide those who are leaving or who have left care with those essential domestic items that families normally provide.




The needs we meet


In 2020 we made grants amounting to £53,483.00, meeting needs as follows:





Numbers applying for and receiving grants




